White House Retreat is a Jesuit Retreat House based on The Spiritual Exercises of Saint Ignatius. Three-day preached retreats are offered throughout the year. On each retreat there are four or five priests available for private conferences and the celebration of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick. Mass is celebrated each day and at night there is Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Your retreat is a silent retreat. Each retreatant makes himself totally available to the Lord and refrains from all conversation with fellow retreatants (except during the opening and closing meals and the optional Fellowship Period following dinner in the evening). Since 1922 people of faith have been coming to the retreat house on the high bluffs overlooking the Mississippi River about twenty miles south of downtown St. Louis.
